- It is to be signed each week by parents/guardians.

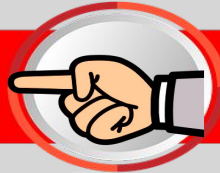




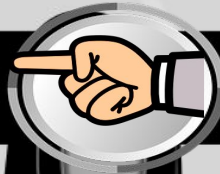
